

# **Pastor's Letter**

April 27/28

# The Road Ahead

Dear Parish Family,

This June, I will mark twelve years as pastor of Sacred Hearts. That is a significant number, as pastors everywhere in our church receive six-year appointments and often move to a new assignment after the second term is completed. I came to Sacred Hearts in 2012 after serving two terms as pastor of Our Lady of Lourdes in West Islip. I am also at an age when priests can choose to retire. When our personnel director asked what I would like to do, I told him I would like to continue as the pastor of Sacred Hearts, provided that I have the energy and health to do so. So, I was delighted to receive a call from Bishop Barres, informing me that he agreed with my request and asking if I would continue here at Sacred Hearts. I fell in love with Sacred Hearts very quickly, a feeling that grows only deeper each year. I feel very blessed to be able to continue my ministry here.

Looking back over these years, we have accomplished so much together. Our ministries have grown and taken on many new directions. Together we have survived a pandemic that tested many people's connection to their church. Now we have more parishioners who have joined the parish and more people attending Mass each week than ever before. We have made many repairs and restorations to our church and parish grounds. It is hard to remember what life was like before air conditioning in the church. There is so much to be grateful for. And though it is good to look back, the road ahead is always the most important to me. So here are a couple of ideas for these next years.

I hope we can do some serious work on our parish social ministry this summer. In a sense, parish social ministry is what happens after Mass. It is also described as the corporal works of mercy: to reach out to the needy, the homebound, the sick, the elderly, and all those who need the advocacy of our church. I especially want to work with Catholic Charities and Catholic Health Services to bring many new kinds of service to the people of the parish and our community.

I also want to begin a project this summer to restore the auditorium of our school building. Did you know that 2024 is the 100th anniversary of this building? Though it has many roles to play in our parish, one of the most important is that other than the church, it is the only place we have for large gatherings of people. We have increasingly larger gatherings, from longstanding programs like our Angel Tea to new programs such as our Lenten Soup Supper and Family Project Sundays. But the auditorium is in sad shape and needs a serious renewal to serve us well.

You will hear more about these projects soon, so no worries. I will not be sitting back and resting on memories. There is always so much more to do.



Reflection On the Gospel May 5, 2024

This is my commandment: love one another as I love you.
